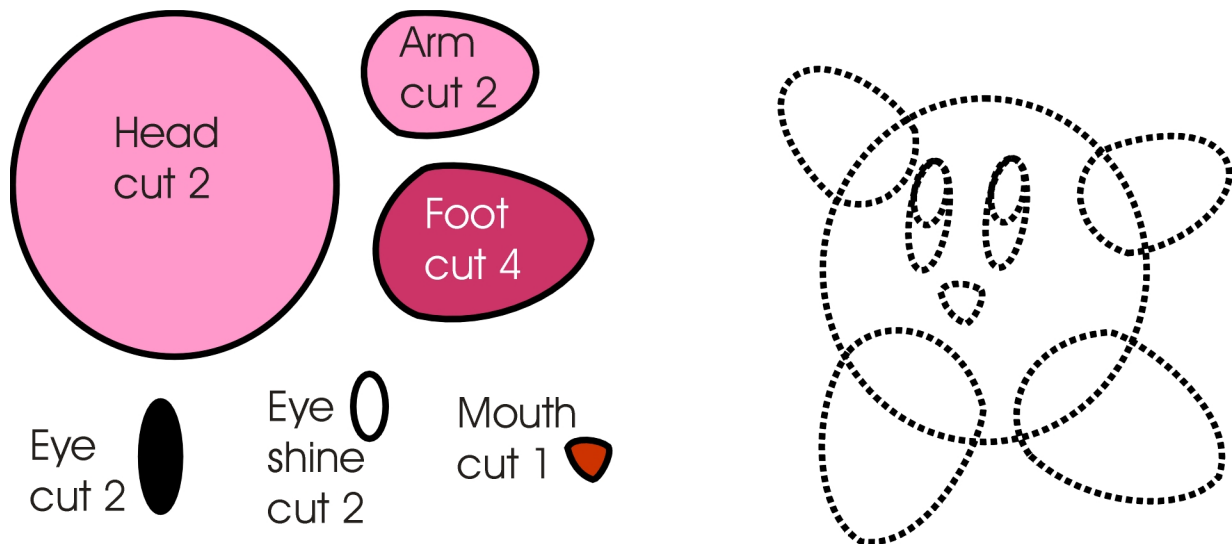


Kirby Mascot

Supplies

- Felt in the following colors: pink, dark pink/magenta, red, black, white. Wool felt is recommended, but synthetic felt will work as well.
- Thread or embroidery floss in pink and red.
- Craft glue
- Very sharp, fine point scissors. My favorites are Gingher Tailor Points/Craft Scissors. <http://gingher.com/product/5-knife-edge-craft-chrome-finish/91/> If I had to choose one set of scissors to take with me to a desert island, these would be them. Assuming of course I could take fabric as well. ☺

Pattern



Instructions

Cut pieces in colors and amounts as shown on the pattern below. Follow the dotted-line diagram for placement of pieces. In all cases, sew with a double thickness of thread, using an overcast/whip stitch.

1. On one head piece glue black eye pieces in the positions shown in diagram. Glue white eye shines over the black eye pieces as shown. Glue mouth piece into position shown. Press down to make sure it adheres to the felt.
2. Sew two foot pieces together using an overcast stitch in red/magenta thread. Start at the heel and stop a half inch short of where you started, leaving an opening. Stuff the foot with a small piece of stuffing, and complete stitching the opening. Knot and cut of thread tail. Repeat for other foot.

3. Starting at the bottom, sew the two head pieces together using a whip/overcast stitch in pink thread. Sew arm pieces in to the seams as you stitch, with them sandwiched between the head pieces. You have to stitch through the arms as you overcast the head in those areas.
4. Stop ½ inch short of where you started, leaving an opening to stuff the head. It will take more stuffing that you would think. Once its stuffed, continue sewing the opening closed. Knot off and snip the thread.
5. Position the stuffed feet behind the head, in the positions shown on the pattern. You can either sew them down in the back using a whip stitch, or you can glue them on. I recommend doing both it children will be playing with your mascot.
